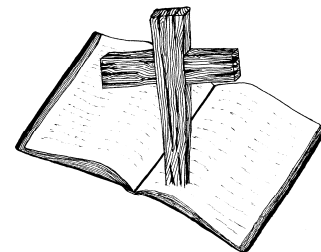

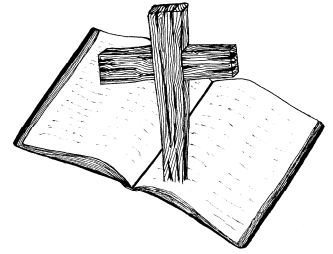

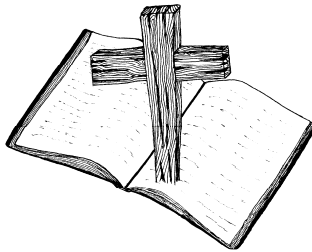
1. The Bible, which is verbally inspired by the Holy Spirit and inerrant in the original manuscripts and is the infallible and authoritative Word of God.

4. The fall and lost estate of man, whose total depravity makes necessary the new birth.

CAMPER RULES

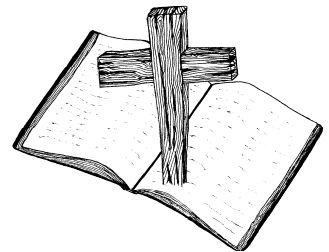
1. You must stay on the camp grounds unless you have permission from the Camp Director or authorized person.
2. Tobacco, drugs and alcohol are not allowed on the camp grounds.
3. All campers must attend all meetings and classes.
4. No food in dorms.
5. No pillow fighting or towel flipping.
6. No meddling with the belongings of others.
7. Please do not deface any part of the buildings or grounds.
8. Wear modest clothing (see dress code).
9. Keep hands off the opposite sex.
10. Couples are not to be off alone.
11. Fireworks of any kind are not permitted at camp.

Guidelines for Dorm Leaders

1. Be in the dorm with your campers when they are scheduled to be there.
2. See that you and your campers abide by the camp rules.
3. Be concerned with the spiritual needs of each camper in your group. Make opportunities to deal with each camper concerning salvation and his relationship to Jesus. (Suggested conversation opener: “How long have you been a Christian?”) Once the conversation is opened; press on!
4. See that campers attend classes, meetings and meals on time. Sit with them and make it a practice to check to see that they are present.
5. Report all problems to the camp director, and any injuries or sicknesses to the camp nurse immediately.
6. Lead your devotional group in evening prayer time and a sharing prayer time before “lights out”.
7. See that lights remain out in your dorm and undue conversation stops after “lights out”.
8. Avoid excessive physical contact with campers & staff of the opposite sex, such as arms around shoulders or waist, etc.
9. Be prepared at all meetings to deal spiritually with any camper coming forward.
